**The App** is specifically dedicated for the youth in our community! The Youth & Community Connect App links youth to resources and services provided by community and faith-based organizations, government agencies and schools.

**4 Ways to Connect** There are 4 easy ways to connect with programs and resources in your community.

Click on any of the 4 main tabs (Agencies, Resources, Criminal Justice Program and Search by Zip Code) and you can get instant access to a list of resources close to you.

**Every Agency receives a detailed page listing** to display a description of the organization and include website information.

All non-profit agencies must be a 501(c)(3) and insured.

**All local resources are easy to find**

Numerous different program categories are available to meet the specific needs of the user. All programs link back to the agency website.

**Criminal Justice Program listings** provides a direct pathway to criminal justice programs available to youth.

**Search by Zip Code for local resources**

With one click, you're connected to programs close to you.

**Is there a fee?**

No, the App is FREE to be a part of and free to use!

**Can anyone join?**

To participate, all agencies must have valid business license and have insurance. All non-profits must be a valid 501(c)(3).

**Is the App available in the Apple or Google Store?**

No, this App is designed so you do not need to visit the store on your mobile device. Open a browser on the mobile device, type in [SacYouthConnect.org](http://SacYouthConnect.org). It is that easy!



**How do I download the App?**

Open a browser on the mobile device, type in [SacYouthConnect.org](http://SacYouthConnect.org). When the App loads on the phone simply "add this to your home screen". The next time you click on the YCC icon the app will be ready to use. It is that easy!

Compatible browsers are Chrome, Edge, and Safari.

**What can I download this App on?**

The App can be downloaded on any mobile device including your cellular phones and tablets. You can even view this on your desktop computer!

**Am I able to have my website or programs updated or modified once on the App?**

Yes, you can contact the Administrator to make those changes. Also, every 6 months, you will receive an email to confirm or provide an update of your organization. To ensure services are current, if we do not receive a response, you will be removed from the App.
