Below are some of the most asked questions that come up during our information sessions.

A few commonly asked questions are:

- **How much does the class cost?**
 - It is free. There are no textbooks. We will provide you with the safety equipment and lend you a set of tools.

- **How long is the class?**
 - The class runs February 22nd, 2022 through March 24th, 2022. Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 8am to 5pm.

- **What's taught during the class?**
 - OSHA 10: a minimum of 10 hours of construction safety and hazard recognition. Upon completion of this module, student will receive a nationally accepted safety training certification.

- **Will the class be all lectures?**
 - No. At first the safety component will be lecture because it is important to make sure you are aware of as many of the dangers that are in a work area. Then we will be working on various projects, field trips, and guest speakers.
