REPACK WORKER (\$15.50/hr.)

4-5 a.m. start, 5 day work week, Split days off Sorts and repacks produce in the Repack Department.

- Lift cases and segregate produce on table to get ready for repacking.
- Sort, bunch, tie and trim produce.
- Place produce in packaging bags, cases and other containers.

RECEIVER (\$17.25/hr. to start)

7-8 a.m. start, 5 day work week, Split days off

Receives, stores and distributes products within the warehouse and surrounding areas following all directives of the supervisor.

- Accurately count and verify all units of each product being received.
- Prepare the product for put-away and put away proper location slots
- Operates battery powered pallet jacks and forklifts and non-powered material handling equipment on a regular basis.

ORDER SELECTOR (\$17.50/hr. to start plus weekly production Incentive)

3 p.m. start, 4/5 day work week, Split days off

Selects products in the warehouse and other areas to satisfy customer orders. Also receives and stores products within the warehouse and surrounding areas.

- Uses electric pallet jack to palletize orders
- Uses electronic device to locate and confirm all items/orders
- Loads pallets onto trucks

INVENTORY CONTROL SPECIALIST (\$17/hr. to start)

5 a.m. - 7 a.m. start time, Monday - Friday, *Schedule may change Conducts cycle counts, ensures that the physical inventory matches the system inventory to the lot numbers. Responsible for identifying and reviewing inventory discrepancies. Works closely with other department for the resolution of inventory discrepancies.
