## Referral/Application

A referral/online application for a student is received by the SETA/ Sacramento Works STEPS Team along with forms DR 203 and DR 206













#### **Initial Contact**

The STEPS Team makes contact with the student/guardian and explains the 5 services STEPS offers:

- 1. Job Exploration Counseling (JEC)
- 2. Work Readiness Training Work (WRT)
- 3. Self-Advocacy Training (SAT)
- 4. Work-Based Learning Experiences (WEX, Informational Interviews + Job Shadowing)
- 5. Postsecondary Enrollment Counseling (PEC)

# **Payroll Document** Collection

The STEPS Team will gather payroll documents to ensure Right-to-Work status and verify a student has the ability to obtain a work permit (applicable to minors)

### **Services Start**

The student will be given to option to participate in Service #1 or #2 or #3 prior to moving onto Services #4 + #5

## **Program Exit**

Once students have recieved at minimum 4 of the 5 offered servies they can be exited.
