PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Must have an IEP or 504 Plan
- Must be 16 years or older and enrolled and attending school
- Attend mandatory (unpaid) work readiness workshop
- Must be able to work part-time/full-time during summer
- Must be able to work independently
